The Health Science sector has a **\$79 Billion** Economic Impact on Indiana's Economy



Indiana sectors of health science excellence include: **Metabolic Disease, Cancer, Regenerative Medicine, Neurologic Disease and Conditions, and Health Informatics**

In 2019, Indiana's three research universities reported over **\$1.3 Billion** in research funding

There are over **2,100** health science companies in Indiana.

The Indiana University School of Medicine is the **largest research medical school in the country** with student enrollment of over 1,500 annually.
